



WANNEROO JOONDALUP TEE BALL CLUB 2019 STATE TEE BALL CHAMPIONSHIPS SELECTION TRIAL INFORMATION



CHAMPIONSHIPS:

They are held on Sat 2nd, Sun 3rd & Mon 4th March, 2019 (Long Weekend), at Langley Park, Perth.

SELECTION TRIALS:

- The selection trial will be on Sunday 4th Nov 2018 at **Percy Doyle Reserve, Duncraig**.
- Players are to wear their long grey pants, a **suitable tee shirt, socks, shoes** and their **black club hat**.
- **No Saturday Team shirts or State Uniforms or Orange caps are to be worn.**
- * Players wearing shorts or without a hat will NOT be permitted to try out.

- Timing for Trials:

U9 & U10 _____ 9:00am – 12.00pm
U11, U12 & U13 _____ 1:00pm – 3:30pm

* Please make sure that you arrive 20 minutes before your allocated time for your age group, to collect your Bib No.

STATE TEAMS:

There will be an “A” team selected in each division that the club nominates. A subsequent “B” team will only be selected if sufficient nominations are received. Final confirmation of team’s acceptance at the championships comes from TBAWA.

SELECTION TRIALS ATTENDANCE:

If you choose to participate in the trial, attendance on Sunday 4th Nov, 2018 is **compulsory**. If you cannot attend the trial, then a **letter is required, in writing**, explaining the reasons why you cannot attend. This will be discussed by a Committee panel and if accepted, the Chief Coaches can make a judgment of the player’s ability from the player’s Saturday game performance, however there are no guarantees.

*** A previous year state team participation DOES NOT guarantee an automatic inclusion.**

EVERYONE STARTS FROM SCRATCH.

STATE TEAM SELECTIONS:

Each team will comprise of a maximum of twelve (12) players. If there are twelve (12) or less nominating players in a particular division at the trial date, it does not mean an automatic selection. If more than 12 nominations are received for a particular division then the trial or judgment will determine selection.

*** PLEASE NOTE:- The State Championships is a TBAWA ‘Age Carnival’ – that is, players cannot play in an age division below their school group age, so if your child is currently playing in a lower age group for any reason as approved by our Club, they must play in the correct higher age division at the State Championships. Players should be “Under” the age as at 30th June 2019.**

STATE TRAINING:

State team commitments comprise 2 **compulsory** training sessions a week. Please note that Sunday State training could be a possibility depending on the Coach.

Please remember, this is a total commitment, not only by the players but also by the parents.

UNIFORM:

All selected players will need to purchase a **state playing shirt** and **orange hat**. They will be loaned a training uniform, black pants & belt for the pre-state carnivals and championship weekend.

* (Uniform will be the same as last year, so returning players will not need to purchase any new uniform).

PLEASE NOTE: That any behaviour in an un-sporting like manner will not be tolerated – this includes, but is not limited to: criticism, throwing of equipment (mitt, bat and helmet) in disgust, foul language or any intimidation untoward any other player. The WJTBC reserves the right to remove a player from the trials if this is not complied with.



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STATE ADHERENCE GUIDELINES

PLAYERS

1. The WJTBC encourages all players to try out for a spot in a State Championship Team.
2. Respect the Coach, respect the Game, respect your Team members and respect the Club – at all times.
3. Players will attend all state training sessions, be a willing participant and follow the Coach's directions at all times. (If unavailable to attend, Coach must be informed).
4. Placement of players in the field is determined by the Coach's judgment of the player's ability for each position; players will accept Coach's decision.
5. Any offences such as bullying, swearing, name calling or putting a team member down in any way or bringing the game into disrepute, may result in disciplinary action.
6. Any offences as above against opposition teams will also not be tolerated.
7. Players will be correctly attired for training and for official games as designated by the Coach/Manager.
8. Accept that at some point during the game you will take your turn on the bench. When on the bench, encourage your team and be prepared to play at all times.
9. You are representing the WJTBC, therefore the Club expects you to show sportsmanship attributes at all times.
10. Remember that you are part of a TEAM!

PARENTS

1. **The Team Coach has sole control of the team**, unless he/she delegates his/her duty to an assistant or another parent.
2. Will not use any threatening, intimidating or malicious comments or gestures towards the Coach, Manager or any other team official.
3. Any problems that may arise and becomes an issue within the team, is to be discussed through the Chief Coach and a Committee member.
4. The selection process for team selection that the WJTBC has in place is the fairest way to select a team, as the players are graded on their ability alone, against their peer group average. Results are final.
5. Respect officials' decisions and teach your children to do likewise. If you disagree with any decision, use the proper channels and do not disrupt or query officials during the game.
6. Foul language of any sort will not be tolerated and stern action will be taken against offenders.
7. If any parent has any questions or concerns, they are to discuss these with the CHIEF COACHES. Discussions are confidential.
8. Remember that you are representing the Club, whilst at the Championships.
